

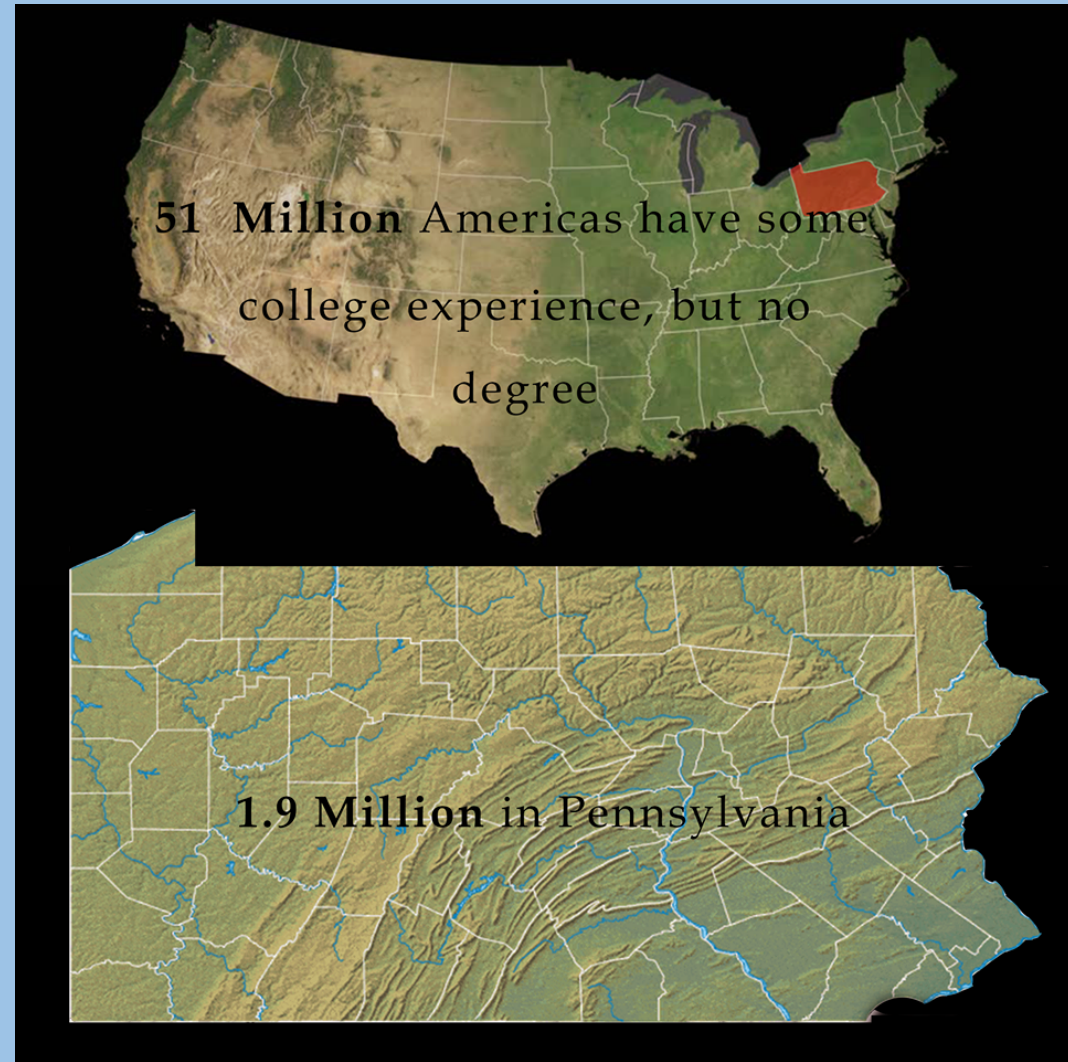

# Many Credits – Little Utility

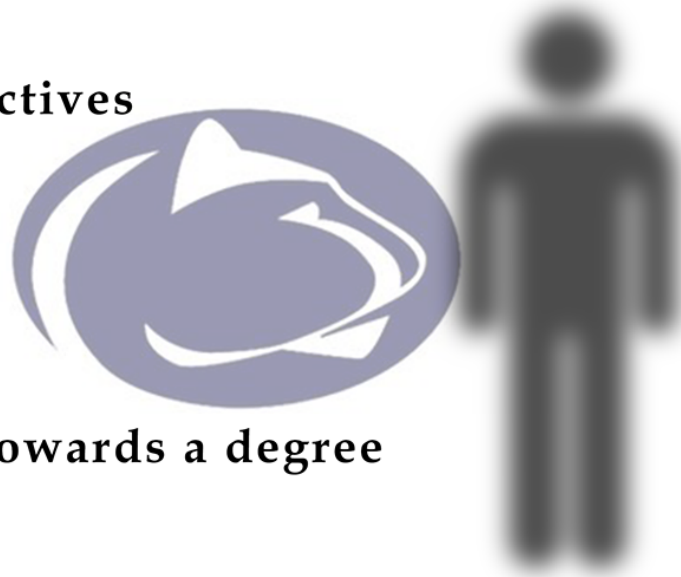


83% of students have a large number of transfer credits.

33% gen ed

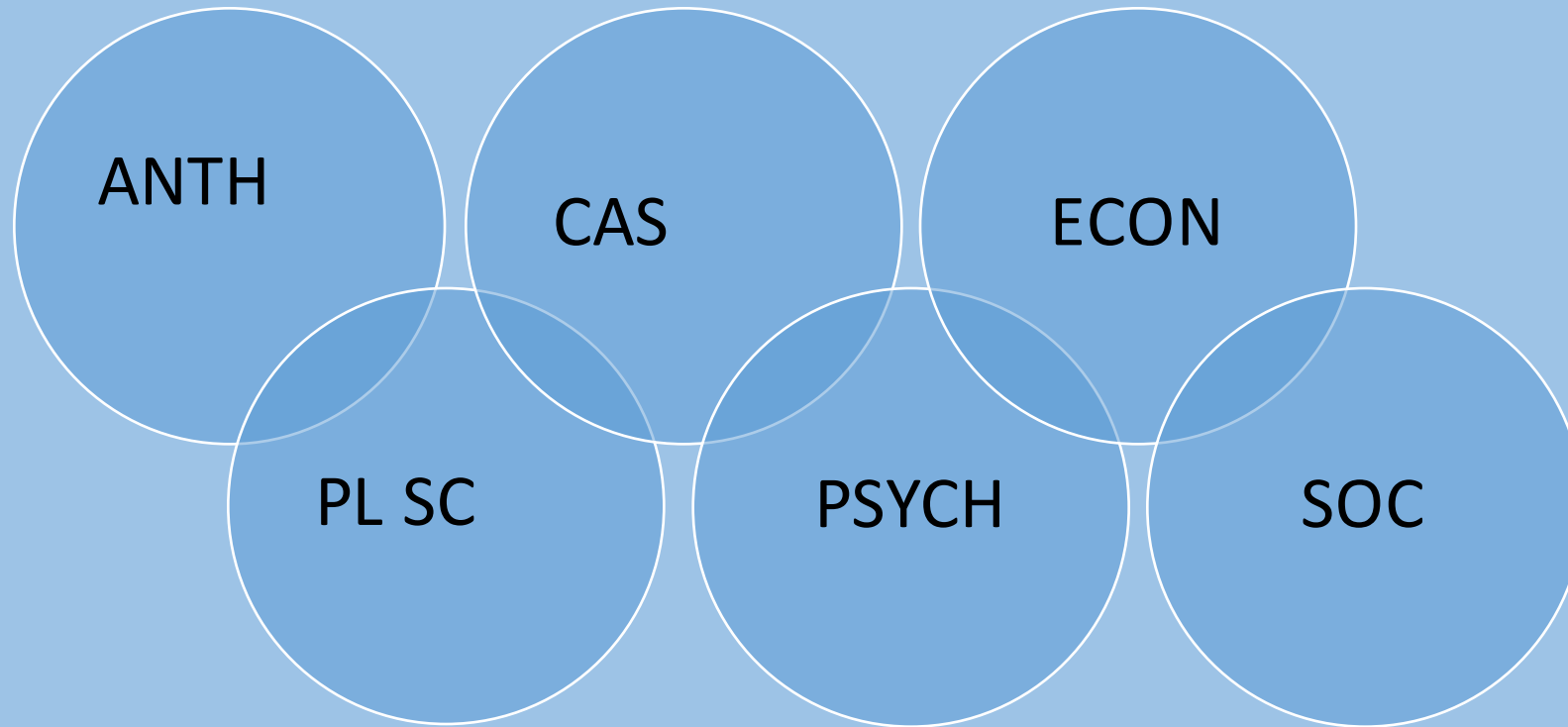
18% count towards a degree
