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What is PLA?

Prior Learning Assessment is the process of determining whether knowledge gained outside of the traditional academic environment is at the college-level and worthy of college credit.



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PLA Importance

According to a 2010 study on PLA and adult student outcomes conducted by the Council for Adult and Experiential Learning (CAEL), students with PLA credits had better academic outcomes, especially in terms of graduation rates and persistence, than non-PLA students, and many significantly shortened the time required to earn their credential.





Between 2008 and 2014 in Pennsylvania, 45,048 students transferred: 56% transferred once, 28% twice, and 15% three times or more.

In 2015—2016, Penn State students transferred 102,630 courses.
