- Comments for the Good of the Order
 - Bill asked Whitney if she could think about what research questions CAL should be thinking about asking. The decline in the adult learner population is troublesome.
 - Whitney shared that she may not be the proper person to pull retention data for the broader university. We should ask <u>OPAIR</u> if they have this information.
 - Whiteny looked at the OPAIR website- data from 2018-2022. They report on Fall admits. This will not represent the SP admits.
 - Chuck Greggs asked Bill what WC adult learners look like.
 - Bill share that most WC adult learners are attending Part-time
 - WC has also seen a decrease in adult learners, perhaps due to cost of living, changes to financial aid.
 - $\circ\quad$ WC is seeing an increase in traditional age students- this is not intentional.
 - JoAnne Kelly shared that from the GV perspective, Artificial Intelligence degree is getting a lot of interest. We see degrees cycle in and out. Employers are looking at retention and offering tuition reimbursement programs.
 - How did the pandemic
 - Leslie mentioned conversations at CAEL that focused on the lack of recruitment effort for adult learners, and they are the fastest growing population of students.
