 - Plans to create a list of recommendations, which will be finalized in the coming months.
 - Aim to package a full suite of resources and services into a simplified and streamlined access point, emphasizing safety nets and community support.

- Efforts underway to compile recommendations for areas and departments responsible for addressing these barriers.
 - Involves comprehensive approach to addressing institutional, departmental, and specific unit-level barriers hindering adult learner success.

 - Share individual and departmental efforts with JoAnn to ensure comprehensive representation.
 - Aims to articulate focus and charge clearly, ensuring alignment with University's goals and priorities.
