EOY Reports

- Chairs reminded that reports are due in June.
- Proposal to focus on transfer credits collectively across committees instead of individual sections, potentially enhancing the case to faculty senate and sponsors.
 - Agreement reached; Strat-comm aims to communicate transfer credit strategy with detailed suggestions/recommendations and review potential models.
 - Emphasis on specificity, addressing low-hanging fruit without extensive debate.
 - Plan to compile a list at the next meeting.
 - \circ $\;$ Recognized as a broader issue affecting student retention beyond adult learners.
- Inquiry into data on students with transfer credits or potential enrollment growth strategies.
 - Difficulty capturing pre-application student loss; proposed examination of yield rates universitywide.
 - Challenge of lacking audit data and incomplete student profiles.
- Affordability discussed as a key concern; example provided of <u>Franklin University's cost calculator and</u> preferred pathway program.
- Caution against fixation on minor details; anticipation of thorough discussion at the next meeting. **New Business**
 - Open floor for additional topics.
 - Interest expressed from a member of the Hendrick Family to join and contribute to the Commission; to be invited and onboarded at the April meeting.
